## Take Down The Canopy

## Step1

- Detach hook and loop straps from the top and curtains.


## Step2

- Raise a leg off the ground and depress the snap button to disengage the lower leg. Repeat until all four legs have been lowered.


## Step3

- Pull the ring on the slider at each corner bracket to disengage the frame and allow it to close.


## Step4

- Remove elastic loops on the top from each eave extension corner.
- Stand opposite a partner and grasp the lower truss bar. Lift the frame off the ground and slowly walk toward partner being careful not to pinch fingers.


## Step5

- Remove canopy top and completely close the frame. We recommend storing canopies without the top to avoid mildew and pinch tears.


## Step6

- Store frame and top in roller bag.

## Set Up The Canopy

## Step1

- Stand the Instant Canopy frame upright in the center of the desired set-up location.
- Stand opposite a partner and lift frame off the ground walking backwards away from partner.


## Step2

- Turn up each thin pole which connect to the roof pole.
- Attach a small canopy top to the four thin pole to become a small roof.



## Step6

- Extend each inner leg to raise canopy to the desired height by stepping on the lower footpad and allowing the snap button to lock in place.



## Step7

- Attach corner curtains to top truss bars (a) (b) \& (c).



## Step8

- Your Instant Canopy is now complete!



## Step5

- Attach the hook and loop straps to each corner and overhead truss bars.
