This product allows parents to sleep next to their baby without sharing the same bed. It can be used as a normal crib or as a co-sleeper. It can be adjusted to different height levels and can be used at an inclined level to help with baby's congestion and reflux.






ATTACH TO THE CRIB



TO AVOID DEATH FROM THE INFANTS NECK BEING CAUGHT ON THE TOP RAIL ON THE SIDE THAT IS NEXT TO THE ADULT BED, THE TOP RAIL MUST BE NO HIGHER THAN THE ADULT MATTRESS. ALWAYS RAISE THE SIDE WHEN NOT FASTENED TO THE ADULT BED.


AWARNING

FALLING HAZARD—To help prevent falls, do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached [insert manufacturer's recommended maximum weight], 22LBS(10kgs) whichever comes first.

ACCESSING THE WEBBING STRAPS



Insert the 2 "males buckles" to the 2 "female buckles" on the buttom of the base. Adjust the safety straps to the correct length. Then secure and lock in place.



Fix the two sets of adjustment straps on the big bed and adjust the adjustment straps to a suitable position.



A label shall be located on the product as close to the attachment point as possible and shall address that the attachment system must always be used in bedside sleeper mode (manufacturer shall insert a visual cue graphic here specific to their product).

OPERATION MODE AND ADJUSTMENT INSTRUCTIONS




1. As shown in the picture, open the zipper on both sides of the bed.



2. As shown in the picture, press and hold the buttons on both sides below to remove the tube of bed.



3.As shown in the picture, open it.




4. As shown in the picture, lock the fixing belt to the bed to prevent it from moving.



WARNING

Information on the types of adult beds with which the bedside sleeper CANNOT be used. Graphics shall be used showing an unacceptable bed configuration with the mattress, box springs not in line with the frame (such as some platform beds) and conversely an acceptable bed configuration with the mattress, box springs and frame all in line (see Fig. 5 for examples).

The attachment sysyem must ALWAYS be used in bedside sleeper mode.


The 2 attachment straps must always be used in bedside sleeper mode.



CLEANING AND CARE



This product requires regular maintenance. The cleaning and maintenance of this product must only be carried out by an adult. CLEANING The mattress have fabric covers that are completely removable and washable. Check the product regularly for signs of wear and damage and to ensure that it is assembled correctly. Should any part be damaged, do not use it and keep it out of reach of children. Do not clean the product with solvents, abrasive or harsh products. Please refer to the care label for instructions on cleaning the fabric parts of this product. Below are the cleaning symbols and their meanings:











Hand wash in cold water.

You can use a hand-held steamer for the outside fabric that is wrinkled.

CLEANING PARTS Periodically wipe clean aluminum parts with a soft damp cloth. Always dry the aluminum parts to prevent the formation of rust. Do not immerse the floor boards in water. Spot clean the inside and outside fabric .Wipe clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent ,air dry completely before use. WARNING SOME PARTS ARE NOT MACHINE WASHABLE, PLEASE FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS.

MOVING THE CRIB

RECOMMEND WEIGHT FOR CHILD: 10KG//22 POUNDS DO NOT EXCEED WEIGHT

A WARNING

▲ WARNING: STRANGULATION/ SUFFOCATION HAZARD: The top edge of the lowering bar must be level with or below the top of the adult mattress when used as a Co-sleeper// bassinet. The level of the mattress must be a minimum of 4 inches below the top edge of the lowering bar. NEVER raise the level of the mattress level with, or above the top of the lowering bar of the product. To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult mattress. ALWAYS raise the side and convert to bassinet mode when not fastened to the adult bed as a co sleeper mode.

▲ WARNING: NEVER USE as co sleeper without the anchor plate attached. Always lock the anchoring system in proper place as shown in the diagram. Failure to use the anchoring system could result in serious injury or death to the infant. Make sure all straps are secured and tight. Check straps before each use when using the product as a Co-Sleeper// bedside bassinet.

▲ WARNING: STRANGULATION/ CHOKING HAZARD: DO not allow excess strap or any lose objects to find it's way into the product when a child inside the product.

Do Not allow excess strap to lay loose on floor because it can cause accidental slips and falls into or towards the product.

▲ WARNING: Entrapment Hazard -To prevent death from entrapment ,this product must be properly secured to the adult bed using the attachment system.

There must be no more than 1/2 inch (13mm) gap between the bedside sleeper and the adult bed. Check tightness before each use by pulling the product in a direction away from the bed.



DO NOT USE IF GAP EXCEEDS 1/2 inch (13mm). DO NOT FILL GAP WITH PILLOWS OR BLANKETS OR STUFFING or any items than can cause suffocation!

- ▲ WARNING: Make sure all Velcro straps are secured and tight when used in the position. Tighten straps periodically of this product.
- ▲ WARNING: Failure to use this securing system will allow the product to move away from the adult bed and could result in infant falling out of this product when used as a Co sleeper// bassinet. NEVER leave infant unattended.
- ▲ WARNING: Do not tilt more than 1 level for RE FLUX or congestion mode. The height adjustment between the head to foot should be no more than 2 inches (5cm) for tilting.
- ▲ WARNING: Keep children far away from this product when assembling and disassembling. This product is not a TOY, do not let children play with this product.
- ▲ WARNING: This product is designed for use only with adult beds that are between 43cm// 17 inches and 58 cm// 23inches from floor to top of adult mattress. The product should only be used as a bedside co sleeper of this guide height.
- ▲ NEVER have the child inside this product, the co-sleeper// bassinet when detaching from the bed /moving or assembling or disassembling.



FALLING HAZARD

Remove the infant from the product when doing any adjustments.

WARNING— Top revent serious or fatal injury from falls always keep child in arm's reach. Never leave a child unattended. Use your co sleeper // bassinet according to manufacturers' directions. Only use the mattress provided with the cosleeper// bassinet, do not add extra padding.



NEVER place the co sleeper// bassinet near a window with blinds, curtain cords or baby monitor cords, babies can strangle on cords.



NEVER place on uneven surface.



Do not tilt or put on anything except the floor to accommodate the bed height.



NEVER LEAVE A child unattended, always implement responsible adult supervisions.

WARNING



SUFFOCATION HAZARD



INFANTS can suffocate in gaps between extra padding and side of co sleepler // bassinet, and On soft bedding. Use only the pad provided by manufacturer.



NEVER add a pillow, comforter or another mattress for padding. If is sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided by the manufacturer. To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their back to sleep, unless other wise advised by your physician.



A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for infant until he or she begin to push upon hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage. -To prevent death from entrapment, bedside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system. -There must be no 1/2 in. (13 mm) gap between bedside sleeper and



CHECK tightness before each use by pulling bedside sleeper in a direction away from adult bed. -If gap exceeds 1/2 in. (13 mm), DO NOT use this product. Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards. Always read and follow assembly instructions for each product use mode (bedside sleeper, bassinet). Always use ALL required parts for each use mode. Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts. The anchor plate and strap assembly must always be used in bed side sleeper mode.



DO NOT use bedside sleeper if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact our customer service for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.



WARNING



NEVERUSE substitute parts. Assemble product according to manufacturer's instructions for ANY use mode—bedside sleeper as well as the bassinet. To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be ON Higher than the adult bed mattress. Never permit bedding from the adult bed to extend into the Bedside Sleeper.NEVER LEAVE your infant unattended in the Co-Sleeper bed side bassinet.



STRINGS can cause strangulation! Never place items with a string around a child's neck such as hood strings or pacifier cords. DO NOT suspend strings over the unit in any configuration or attach string to toys. NEVER LEAVE infant in product without the TOP HORIZONTAL RAIL installed in the upper most position, unless securely attached to the adult bed.



Always check to be sure that the upper locking bars are secured properly when in bassinet mode and the lower part is Velcro properly under, when in CO SLEEPER MODE, before placing the infant in the co sleeper//bassinet.

WARNING! ONLY use height adjustments on the baby bassinet. DO NOT try to put on anything to give it more height if your bed is too high! Do no tilt on 2 legs or lean forward to try and accommodate bed height. The legs must be level and flat on the floor. Must be used on an even surface!!! Do not put the co-sleeper// bassinet on uneven surfaces.

NEVER use plastic bags or other plastic film as mattress covers for that purpose. They can cause suffocation!!!Only use the products that are sold with the co-sleeper// bassinet.

Make sure all straps are secured and tight when used in the co-sleeping position. Tighten straps periodically.

SUFFOCATION// ENTRAPMENT HAZARD

Do not put anything inside the co sleeper// bassinet, "BARE IS BEST" to prevent SIDS NEVER use loose sheets, blankets or put toys inside the sleep environment of the cosleeper// bassinet.



To prevent suffocation, NEVER place pillows or thick quilts in a baby's sleep environment.

BARE IS BEST.



Make sure there are no gaps larger than two fingers between the sides of the and the mattress.



Proper assembly is paramount: TO AVOID ANY UNFORTUNATE CIRCUMSTANCES.

Follow the instructions provided and make sure that every part is installed correctly. If you are not sure, call the manufacturer for assistance.



Do not use co sleeper// bassinet if it is broken or modified. Infants can strangle to death if their bodies pass through gaps between loose components or broken slats while their heads remain entrapped.



Set up properly. CAREFULLY READ ALL INSTRUCTION.

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ASSEMBLING AND USING THE PRODUCT

This product is intended for use for babies aged between 0 and 5 months, weighing up to a maximum of 22 lbs,10 kgs.

WARNING: When a child is able to sit, kneel or to pull itself up, the crib shall not be used any more for this child.

WARNING: Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gasfires, etc.

Before assembly, check that the product and all of its components have not been damaged during transportation. Should any part be damaged do not use and keep out of reach of children.

WARNING: Do not use the product if any part is broken, torn or missing.

WARNING: The product is ready for use only when all locking mechanisms are engaged.

Check carefully that these are engaged before use.

WARNING: In bassinet and cradle mode, always make sure that the side rail is raised,

and the zippers are completely closed.

All opening, adjusting, anchoring and positioning operations of the product must be carried out exclusively by an adult.

Before using in "Co-sleeping mode" (Fixed to the bed)" make sure the product is properly anchored and positioned.

The product must always be placed on a horizontal surface. Never leave the product on an inclined surface with the child inside of it.

WARNING: When the product is used in "Co-sleeping mode" (Fixed to the bed)", before laying the child in it, make sure that the connection belts are hooked and tensioned properly, the product must be secured to the parents' mattress and no gaps between the products and the adults' mattress must be present.

Make sure the users of this product are knowledgeable on its proper operation. Children must not be permitted to play without supervision near the product.

Use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer. Do not apply accessories to the product, which are not supplied by the manufacturer.

Do not adjust the product with the child inside.

Do not move the product with the child inside.

Do not leave any objects inside the product that could reduce its depth.
