

FULL SPECTRUM LED FLOOR LAMP

Led Floor lamp Assembly Instructions:

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- 1. Never pull the power cord when removing the lamp from the packaging.
- 2. Remove all packing material and tape from the lamp.
- 3. Read all instructions carefully before you begin assembly.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

Take all the lamp parts out of the carton and set them aside.

- 1. Start by feeding the power wires for the lamp head through the 2-part lamp shaft so they project out of the bottom of the shaft.
- 2. Be sure that the shaft is right-side-up. NOTE: there are stickers at the bottom end of each shaft section to indicate the correct direction.
- 3. With the head still not connected to the shaft, connect the wires at the bottom of the shaft to the lamp base. Make sure to match the wire colors-black to black and white (or blue) to white.
- 4. With wires connected, slide lower-shaft section down onto base plug taking care not to pinch the wires. Next, connect the upper and lower shaft sections- Excess wire should be doubled-up where the 2 shaft sections meet. Be careful to tuck all excess wire safely inside the shaft and avoid pinching wire with the shaft.
- 5. Connect the two shaft sections, the base and the lamp head with the screws provided.
 - It is help to set the base flat on the floor or a level and stable surface such as a table. Make sure that the screw holes line up correctly. If the holes do not line up nicely, it's possible that one
 - or both shaft sections are upside-down. You may need to push downward on the shaft and wiggle it some to get full connection. NOTE: be careful not to pinch your fingers, grab the shaft well above the connection point.
 - Using the screws provided, fasten the bottom shaft to the base plug with a Philips screw driver(not provided).
 - Connect the two shaft sections together.
 - Connect the lamp head to the shaft. Carefully tuck excess wire into the shaft while being cautious not to pinch the wires OR yourself in the process.
- 6. Check the lamp for straight and tight assembly. Carefully plug lamp into adequate power supply and test proper function.
- 7. To clean the lamp, wipe with a soft, clean cloth. Not no use polishes or cleaners.

DO NOT USE NEAR FLAMBLE OR COMBUSTABLE MATERIALS KEEP LAMPS AT LEAST 7 INCHES AWAY FROM WALLS AND OBJECTS.
